## CHINA

The People's Republic of China (PRC), commonly known as China, is a state in East Asia. With over 9.5 million km<sup>2</sup>, China is the third largest country of the world by area. China counts another world record, because China is the world's most populous nation, with over 1.3 billion residents.

China is a communist country. Since the country's establishment in 1949 the Communist Part of China has led China under a one-party system. Despite all this, nearly half of the economy has been privatized in the past decades under 'Socialism with Chinese characteristics'. These reforms have helped hundreds of millions of people out of poverty during the 1980s.

Due to its large and stable population, its growing economy and military spending and capabilities, the PRC is often considered an emerging superpower.

The climate of China is extremely diverse; tropical in the south to sub arctic in the north.

China is not a country, it is a different world. The Chinese culture has made one of the greatest artistic contributions to humankind. It is a shame that much of China's ancient art treasures have been destroyed in times of civil war or dispersed by invasion or natural calamity.



### BEIJING

Beijing is China's capital located in the north, however not China's largest city. Beijing do is recognized as the political, educational, and cultural centre of China, while Shanghai and Hong Kong predominate in economic fields.

Although now Beijing is a modern and fashionable city complete with a full 21st Century vitality, you can experience authentic Beijing life and become acquainted with 'old Beijing' by exploring its many teahouses, temple fairs, Beijing's Hutong and Courtyard and enjoy the Peking Opera.

With the biggest central square in the world - Tian'anmen Square, the Forbidden City that is the largest and best-preserved imperial palace complex, Beijing attracts many visitors who all come to wonder at its century-old history and unique cultural relics.

Also at night Beijing has a lot to offer. When you are in Beijing you have to visit Sanlitun Pub Street and the surrounding Embassy Area in Chaoyang District! This is absolutely a must for foreign visitors and young people.



### SHANGHAI

Shanghai is the largest industrial city in China. Furthermore Shanghai has a population of 18.7 million, including 2 million floating population.

Originally, Shanghai was a seaside fishing village. Today Shanghai is a multi-cultural metropolis with both modern and traditional

Chinese features. Shanghai has three key areas of interest to the visitor. These comprise Sightseeing, Business and Shopping centred upon People's Square and along the Huangpu River.

After years of Communist Party-controlled partying—no nightclubs existed in Shanghai until 1992, now you can club in Shanghai. Nowadays for some Shanghai has the hottest nightlife spots.

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

- You decided to do your internship through Stageplaza. Great idea!
- First send me an email in which you explain your interest.
- I will contact you and if you decide to do the internships I will send you 3 documents that you have to return to me:
  - **Application Form**
  - **Signed copy of Terms and Conditions**
  - **Copy of your passport.**
- Send alongside these documents your CV (check <http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/>) and your Motivation Letter. A Motivation Letter must contain a description of your level of education and your working experience related to the internship. As well you should motivate your choice for doing this internship.
- At the time you send all these documents, you will need to cover the **Registration Fee**, and this way, everything will be ready to enrol you in the program.

*Please note that in the Application Form, you will need to describe what kind of tasks would you like to develop. The more we know, the best we can help you, so the best company we will find. Don't feel afraid of writing a lot, to write too little can cause misunderstandings, and consequently, disappointments (And we don't want a sad face!)*

- Your information will be studied by a qualified consultant of Globalplacement and our partner organization, they will accept or decline your booking. (Depending on the possibilities of placing you in a suitable company for your internship, and on your skills and level of the language)

*Please note that in China, the way of arranging internships is quite different when compared to Holland. You might get invited to do an interview by phone*

Once your interview has been successful, your adventure is ready to start.

- The total amount of the program must be covered.
- You have the right to cancel one Work Placement offer, but only for reasonable causes, which will be criticised by a consultant of Stageplaza and our partner organization.

The professional Chinese tutors will be assigned.	

### OTHER HANDY INFORMATION:

#### *Insurance:*

We advise all students who will do an internship in China to get a travel insurance before you leave your own country, with a health insurance. You can get information about this at your insurance company.

#### *Visa Assistance:*

Given the China's law, the program participant is entitled to apply for the Business Visit (F) Visa in order to fulfill your internships in China. The F visa holder is able to stay in China for up to 6 months at the most. The Letter of Invitation written by the internship employer is going to help the participant get the F visa. We make sure that the participant will get this letter.
